What insurance are we offering?

As part of SWATK membership, SWATK has arranged third party public liability insurance for members normally resident in Great Britain, Northern Ireland, the Isle of Man, or the Channel Islands. Cover is given under a policy taken out by SWATK with Zurich Insurance, policy number XAO-122032-2503. The policy has a maximum liability of £5,000,000 in respect of each incident. A copy of the insurance policy is available on request.

SWATK believes that the insurance provided meets the needs of the majority of SWATK members. We have not assessed your individual needs for insurance and you will not receive advice or recommendations from us about your insurance needs.

What to do if you have an accident

In the event of an incident, DO NOT admit liability or fault as this will invalidate your insurance.

Obtain names and addresses of any involved parties, photo's may be useful if possible.
